### Subject: Accessories on Turkish Chefs' Uniforms

In accordance with the 2nd paragraph of the 11th article of the Constitution of Turkish cuisine, it is stated that the Turkish cooks or those representing the Turkish cuisine **cannot use** very exaggerated accessories that are incompatible with our ancient values. Even if symbols-signs of Turkish culture are used on their clothes or uniforms, and that they are not suitable for Turkish cuisine culture. It has been decided that certain signs or symbols specific to different societies, which have no place in ancient Turkish culture, **cannot be placed** on our uniforms and clothes, together with the neck collars.
